

UPPER WALK

Its route consists of flat footbridges, with panoramic views of the falls from the Upper Iguazu River, leaving in sight a fascinating landscape with different points to admire and photograph from the top of the falls. The walk is totally accessible.



LOWER WALK

This walk offers endless views, front, biased, increasingly tangible and massive, shows the jumps in all its splendor and invites you to enter the jungle, offering an intimate contact with nature through a journey that awakens sensations with the unique possibility of standing just below the falls.



DEVIL'S THROAT

The majestic Devil's Throat and its more than 80 meters fall is the most famous and impressive view of the Iguazu Falls.



GREEN TRAIL

The path crosses a bathed in the middle of the subtropical forest and allows visitors to access from the service area to the Cataratas Station and the start of the Upper and Lower Walks. It extends over 655 meters: it is ideal for those who prefer to walk, instead of using the train, and take the trip to observe nature in all its splendor.



MACUCO TRAIL

It is the most rugged path of the park. It is a dirt road in the middle of the jungle that culminates in the Arrechea waterfall, with its pool of water just below the waterfall. This path crosses the territory of the monkey fell, and often, one can meet with the pleasant surprise of seeing groups of them in the treetops. You can see hundreds of butterflies of all colors and hear the birds singing in a unique tranquility in the park.



RECOMMENDATIONS

REMEMBER:

- It is strictly forbidden to take, damage or touch plants or parts of them (flowers, leaves, for example), or any living or dead animal.
- Observe the animals without disturbing them.
- Only drive on authorized trails and respect the established schedules.
- Keep the waste that you produce in a bag until you find a basket where you can throw them away safely.
- Respect the other visitors. Most come in search of tranquility in contact with the nature.
- Wear comfortable clothes and a hat. Carry repellent and water with you at all times.
- It is not allowed to enter the park with pets. Consult for availability of kennels.
- Rental of lockers in the Access Portal until 6pm.
- You can rent strollers for babies in the Access Portal, in the Central Station and in the Cataratas Station.

QUALITY AND ENVIRONMENT

Due to its orientation towards customer satisfaction, Iguazu Argentina was the first Argentine tourist destination to have a certified quality management system (ISO 9001). The Iguazu Falls National Park was also the first in Latin America to certify an environmental standard (ISO 14001), a framework for the development of a sustainable activity. In addition, the Ecological Train of the Jungle uses green fuel and its two 100% electric locomotives were incorporated to further minimize environmental impact. They are the first of their kind dedicated to the transportation of tourists in Latin America.



NATURE WITHOUT BARRIERS

Iguazu Argentina has specially designed wheelchairs for the comfort of people visiting the park and its specific geography. It also offers the service of caddies to transfer people with reduced mobility and wheelchairs, specially adapted for the route of the footbridges.

FULL MOON WALK

Five nights a month you can take the tour to the incredible balcony of the Devil's Throat illuminated only by the clear light of the moon and the stars. This tour with limited places, includes bilingual specialized guides. For reservations please visit iguazuargentina.com
